Once again the Department of New Hampshire has tasked the Officer Jeremy Charron Law Enforcement post 122 with soliciting and selecting the New Hampshire Law Enforcement Officer of the Year for the American Legion. Once the New Hampshire Officer of the Year is selected, our Post along with State Headquarters compiles a package for National Nomination. For more than a decade, our selected Candidates have placed as National Runner Ups about 30% of the time. Manchester Officer Chris Biron was the National Law Enforcement Officer. Another Officer went on to be selected as the National Law Enforcement Officer of the Year for the Forty and Eight Organization (which is also associated with the American Legion); that Officer was Stratham Officer Charles Law.
